Memory Giving

Memory Giving lets you make an online donation in memory of a loved one. It focuses on simplifying the transfer of funds through to charities, enables the gift to be increased through Gift Aid and creates an appropriate forum for donors to offer messages of sympathy to the family and friends.

JustGiving
